



360 PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT

This Partnership Agreement ("Agreement") is entered into upon the date of signature, by and between:

"360" (The Company): Three Sixty Dot Com Dot Ng, Block A1-153 HFP Shopping Complex, Lagos, Nigeria, developers and operators of the 360 Platform. **"The Partner":** The individual or entity whose name, address, and signature appear at the bottom of this document.

1. Purpose and Scope

The Company grants the Partner the exclusive operational rights to promote, manage, and expand the 360 platform within their designated local jurisdiction (the "Territory"). This Agreement establishes a revenue-sharing partnership based on the platform's profitability within that Territory.

2. Financial Terms & Investment

- **Capital Investment:** The Partner agrees to make a one-time non-refundable capital investment of **₦1,000,000 (One Million Naira)** to activate their Partnership status.
- **Phase 1 (Investment Recovery):** The Partner shall earn **100% of the platform's commission/profit** generated strictly within their Territory until the total cumulative earnings equal their initial ₦1,000,000 investment.
- **Phase 2 (Standard Revenue Share):** Upon full recovery of the initial investment, the Partner's earnings will automatically adjust to **50% of all platform commission/profit** generated within their Territory.
- **Remittance:** Partner earnings will be calculated and remitted to the Partner's designated bank account daily at the close of each business day.
- **Amendments:** 360 reserves the right to review and adjust the commission structure as market conditions or platform economics require. Any such changes will be communicated to the Partner in writing prior to implementation.

3. Obligations of the Partner

The Partner agrees to:

- Actively drive grassroots mobilization, marketing, and brand awareness within the Territory.
- Recruit, onboard, and verify local professionals, artisans, and service providers.
- Act as the primary local liaison, fostering community trust and providing localized support.
- Conduct all business in a lawful, ethical manner that upholds the reputation of the 360 brand.

4. Obligations of 360 (The Company)

The Company agrees to:

- Develop, maintain, host, and upgrade the 360 technology, platform, and application infrastructure.
- Fund and execute overarching digital marketing campaigns and targeted advertisements for consumers.
- Provide general, centralized customer support via live chat and official call lines.
- Manage all secure payment processing, escrows, and daily automated wallet remittances.

5. Relationship of Parties

The Partner is an independent contractor. Nothing in this Agreement shall be construed to create an employer-employee relationship, a legal joint venture, or a corporate partnership. The Partner has no authority to bind 360 to any third-party contracts or incur debt in the Company's name.

6. Intellectual Property

All intellectual property, including but not limited to software code, branding, logos, trademarks, user data, and business processes, remains the sole and exclusive property of 360. The Partner is granted a limited, revocable license to use the brand solely for promotional purposes within their Territory during the term of this Agreement.

7. Confidentiality

The Partner agrees to keep all proprietary company information, financial data, user metrics, and business strategies strictly confidential, both during and after the term of this Agreement.

8. Limitation of Liability and Indemnification

The Partner agrees to indemnify and hold 360 harmless from any claims, damages, or legal actions arising from the Partner's local operations, local disputes, or negligence. 360 shall not be held liable for any indirect, incidental, or consequential damages suffered by the Partner.

9. Term and Termination

- **Term:** This Agreement becomes effective upon signature and receipt of the capital investment, continuing indefinitely unless terminated.

- **Termination for Cause:** 360 reserves the right to immediately terminate this Agreement, revoking the Partner's territory rights, if the Partner breaches any terms of this Agreement, engages in fraudulent behavior, or fails to actively maintain local platform growth.
- **Effect of Termination:** Upon termination, the Partner must cease all use of the 360 brand and will forfeit rights to future commissions.

10. Governing Law

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the Federal Republic of Nigeria. Any disputes arising from this Agreement shall be resolved through good-faith negotiation, and if necessary, binding arbitration.
